My association with Mount Litera Zee School, Howrah began in June, 2016. The experience has been invigorating and insightful. The opportunity to work with children and adolescents as well as empower the future of our nation has been exhilarating. Some of the work include: Primary issues addressed in the one on one counselling sessions held with the students include study skills, memory and concentration improvement strategies, dealing with interpersonal relationships in the school and home front, dealing with anger and aggression, coping with bullying and better time management.
